## Children we've helped:

Nalisha is part of a very poor family in Guyana. Her cleft lip prevented her from going to school, gave her difficulty in eating and caused her personal distress. She wondered why she was not normal. After coming to the United States and having corrective



surgery, her life changed. She loved to show people the pictures before her surgery and then smile to show them the 'new' Nalisha! She now attends a local church and loves to sing.



When we met **Asalim** he was five years old.

He was burned so badly at age two that he had not been able to close his eyelids for three years. He came to the United States and had surgery to replace his eyelids in 2003. On a second trip to the US they expanded his nose bridge and corrected his tear ducts. Right now, we're looking for a medical team to donate their services to provide skin grafts for his burn scars. Currently, he is unable to attend school because the scars frighten other children.



**Isaac** was born with an imperforated anus. A colostomy was done in Liberia, Africa. As he grew, his colon began to distend outside of his body and was extremely painful. CCM went to Africa and brought Isaac to the US at 2 1/2 years of age. Six surgeries were performed by Dr. Mark Downing at Bronson Hospital in Michigan, to reconstruct the colon inside of his body. PTL!

Blessing Brown was born with an imperforated anus. When her parents could not sell her, they abandoned her. Blessing was adopted by Dr. Jerry Brown and his wife Angie from Liberia, who sought treatment for her in the U.S. Dr. Marc Downing at Bronson Hospital in Michigan, was able to perform the one corrective surgery she needed.



Little baby Sara was born without a vagina. Through miraculous intervention by God's Hand, we were able to find her in Guyana and bring her to the US for surgery. Two reconstructive surgeries later, performed by Dr. John Park at Motts Children's Hospital in Michigan, she is perfectly normal. This entire story was the beginning of the CCM Mission. This gave us clarity from God that we were doing exactly what He called us to do.
